- 3. Drawbars CANNOT be any higher than 20 inches (Stock, NO ADJUSTMENTS)
- 4. No aftermarket rear end covers.
- 5. Suitcase weights and wheel weights are permitted.
- 6. Can be a 6-volt or 12-volt electrical system.
- 7. MAX tire size: 15.5 x 38 for Classes (4500-5500)
- 8. MAX tire size: 16.9 x 38 for Classes (6500)
- 9. MAX tire size: 18.4 x 38 (7500-8500)
- 10. No aftermarket air filters. STOCK ONLY.
- 11. No electric fans, water pumps, or fuel pumps.
- 12. No racing or airplane fuel. Pump gas or diesel ONLY.
- 13. 1st gear pulling only.
- 14. Only 2 horn warnings will be allowed for going over the speed limit, third warning will result in a DQ
- 15. The Pulling Committee has the right to stop or DQ any tractors operating in an unsafe manner.
- 16. Tractors may be rechecked after the pull if there are any questions of rule violations.
- 17. Drivers must always remain in the seat.
- 18. Only 2 people admitted with each entry, one driver and one helper. Additional pit passes may be purchased.

- 3. Only OEM side panels are permitted.
- 4. No four wheel drives.
- 5. 18" max draw bar height.
- No Turbos
- 7. Draw bar must not be less than 18" from center of rear axle, no more than 1" thick, must have 3" opening, and be no more than 1.5" from edge of the hole to the edge of the hitch plate.
- 8. MAX tire size: 15.5×38 for classes $(4500-5500) 16.9 \times 38$ $(6500) 18.4 \times 38$ (7500) Top cut tires are permitted.
- 9. Front weights not to exceed 11 feet FROM THE CENTER OF THE REAR AXLE.
- 10. No adjustments of hydraulic hitch while pulling.
- 11. All weights must be securely fastened, any loss of weights on track is immediate DQ.
- 12. Wheelie bars permitted.
- 13. Only 2 horn warning will be allowed for going over the 4 mph speed limit, third warning will result in a red flag DQ.
- 14. The Pulling Committee has right to stop or DQ any tractors operating in an unsafe manner.
- 15. Tractors may be rechecked after the pull if there is any questions of rule violations.
- 16. Drivers must always remain in their seat.
- 17. Only 2 people admitted with each entry, one driver and one helper. Additional pit passes may be purchased.

- 1. Helmet, fire suit, leather shoes recommended.
- 2. Must have a kill switch for gasoline and a guillotine for diesel
- 3. Must pull from a solid drawbar.
- 4. Side panels are permitted.
- 5. No four wheel drives.
- 6. 20" max draw bar height.
- 7. Draw bar must not be less than 18" from center of rear axle, no more than 1" thick, must have 3" opening, and be no more than 1.5" from edge of the hole to the edge of the hitch plate.
- 8. MAX tire size: 18.4 x 38. Any Cut Tires are permitted.
- 9. Front weights not to exceed 11 feet from the center of the rear axle.
- All tractors must use same engine as tractor manufacturers (i.e. International with International engine, JD with JD engine, Oliver with Waukesha).
- 11. All weights must be securely fastened, any loss of weights on track is immediate DQ.
- 12. Wheelie bars required.
- 13. No Turbos
- 14. The Pulling Committee has right to stop or DQ any tractors operating in an unsafe manner.
- 15. Tractors may be rechecked after the pull if there is any questions of rule violations.
- 16. Drivers must always remain in their seat.
- 17. Only 2 people admitted with each entry, one driver and one helper. Additional pit passes may be purchased.
- 18. Minimum of 14 years of age are permitted on tractor, all minors must have written consent from parent/guardian with proper ID and must sign a waiver.
- 19. All tractors will be visually inspected prior to pulling, committee has the right to reject any entry.
- 20. No profanity or altercations will be tolerated. This will result in removal from the grounds.
- 21. No alcohol or drugs will be tolerated.
- 22. No prize money will be awarded to 7500 & 8500 weight classes, awards only.

SMICKSBURG 6 MPH RULES WEIGHT CLASSES 4500 - 5500 - 6500

- 1. Minimum age to pull is 14 years. All drivers under 18 MUST have legal guardian's written consent and supervision.
- 2. TRACTOR AND VEHICLE MUST BE OPERATED IN A SAFE MANNER AT ALL TIMES.

 Any tractor in question of it's safety and integrity can be inspected by a South Buffalo Pullers Official. See South Buffalo Volunteer General Ground Rules for more information.
- 3. **SAFETY -** All tractors must have a working kill switch and wheelie bars.
- 4. **DRAWBAR** Draw bar must not exceed 20 inches in height or be less than 18 inches from center of axle to hooking point. No part of the draw bar may extend rearward beyond point of hook. Draw bars must be stationary in all directions. **No Clevises.**
- WEIGHTS Weights must not extend rearward beyond rear tires and cannot be more than 11 feet from the center of the rear axle to the furthest point forward. There will be a 50-pound weight allowance
- 6. TIRES 7 RIMS Tire size maximum 18.4 x 38. Any rim width. Any cut allowed on tires.
- 7. RPMs A maximum RPMs allowed will be 3000 RPMs.
- 8. **SPEED** 6 mph maximum speed limit. Shifting of T/A's is allowed.
- 9. **MOTOR ENHANCEMENT** Turbos allowed. Superchargers (unless factory equipment) and Nitrous are not allowed. Turbos MUST have cross bolts in exhaust.
- 10. **ENGINE/MOTOR** Any engine/motor recognized from the same manufacture/company of that tractor that bolts in with the same number of cylinders with the same cylinder configuration as the tractor model being pulled is allowed. No V-6 or V-8 engines/motors <u>allowed</u>.
